Dear Asaf,

I write in my capacity as trustee of Marlau Trust, which holds 82% of the shares in Raw Mobility Pty Ltd, of which you hold the remaining 18%.

You have called an Extraordinary General Meeting of Shareholders, scheduled for 6:00 PM on 19 January 2026. I confirm that the date and time is suitable and that I will attend in person. I do not use Microsoft Teams and therefore propose that, if the meeting is to proceed, participation be conducted by telephone directly between you and myself.

I consider the meeting to have no practical purpose, as I will be voting against the proposed resolutions and, given my 82% shareholding, the resolutions cannot be passed.

I also wish to clarify a number of points regarding the scope and purpose of the meeting:

1. Scope of Shareholders Meetings

Shareholders meetings are convened to deal with matters concerning the company and its affairs. They are not the appropriate forum for issues relating to third parties. In this case, Brad and Mobivate are external to the company and therefore fall outside the scope of the meeting. Mobivate, as an independent entity, is entitled to engage suppliers of its choice. The same applies to Raw Mobility's other clients, including TCI Health Pty Ltd, who are free to select their preferred service providers.

2. Accuracy Regarding Customers

Your reference to "the customers of Raw Mobility" is incorrect. The only relevant customer of Raw Mobility in the context of your letter is Mobivate. Mobivate's customers are not customers of Raw Mobility Pty Ltd, and your statements to the contrary are inaccurate.

3. Information Requests

Brad has repeatedly requested information regarding your employee (or purported employee). You are obliged under the Corporations Act 2001 and your duties as a director/shareholder to provide this information. I strongly urge you to comply without further delay.

In light of the above, it is clear that proceeding with the meeting serves no proper purpose, and I request that you immediately withdraw the notice of meeting. Brad will not be attending and has no entitlement to do so nor has anyone else.
